Röschitz | AUSTRIA

The winery is located in the municipality of Röschitz at the foot of the Manhartsberg , South of Retz in the West of the lower Austrian wine-growing region of Weinviertel. The family has been resident here for four generations. The business was taken over in 2001 by Leo Maurer jun. (graduate of the Krems School of Viticulture) and his wife Manuela (state-certified wine manager). The parents Alfred and Maria Maurer assist in the vineyard and contribute their experience. The vineyards cover 14 hectares. They are planted with the white wine varieties Grüner Veltliner, Chardonnay, Pinot Blanc, Riesling, Sauvignon Blanc and Gelber Muskateller as well as with the red wine varieties Zweigelt and Blauburger.

Natural, environmentally friendly viticulture is consistently practised. The quality criteria are quantity restriction through short pruning and rigorous thinning. Only ripe and healthy grapes are processed through selective manual harvesting. The white wines are matured in steel tanks, the red wines traditionally in large wooden barrels.

Champagne Autreau de Champillon

Champagne | FRANCE

The history of the Autreau family and their influence in the Champagne region dates as far back as 1670. Though the art of making Champagne was not thought of at this time the Autreau family was one of artists whose works today find their place in the Louvre Museum and Castel of Versailles in Paris.

It is this philosophy of art that the family today brings to the production of their wines. Previously simply growers who sold their grapes to the mansions of the region it was in the 1950s that Gerard Autreau decided to keep his grapes and start down the road of making his own wines. The estate now has been passed through to three generations of winemakers, onto Eric and his son, Laurent.

The estate today spans over 33 hectares in the terroirs of Champillon, Ay, Chouilly, and Verneuil. The vines are meticulously cared for using sustainable viticulture techniques where the number of interventions are limited and only friendly treatments are utilised on the vines. This commitment has seen the estate receive a High Environmental Value Level 3 and Sustainable Viticulture certification.

Château Barbebelles

Provence | FRANCE

Château Barbebelles is one of the oldest properties in Aix en Provence, dating from Roman times. Today it has a 16th century Château, 45 hectares of vines along with a preserved and authentic 300 hectares of forest. It is owned by the Herbeau family. A history that now continues with the 4th generation: Madeleine Herbeau joining her father in the business.

Together, they are developing the winery into one of the most prestigious Rosè producers in Aix en Provence.

Champagne Leon Launois

Champagne | FRANCE

Passed down from generation to generation, Champagne Leon Launois traces the history of one of the oldest families in Champagne.

Historically deployed in Le Mesnil-sur-Oger, this exceptional terroir is located on the famous Côte des Blancs, a true "Grand Cru" gem.

With a qualitative supply in the best crus of Champagne, the cuvées are produced in the latest generation thermo-regulated stainless steel vats, restoring authentic aromas and guaranteeing a subtle marriage between tradition and modernity.

In the favorable shade of their traditional cellars, sheltered from the vagaries of time, the finest cuvées and vintages have been patiently resting for several decades. Very rare bottles are still present in the heart of their exceptional Oenotheque with vintages such as 1955, 1959, 1961, 1964, 1970, 1973 and 1989.

Jean-Philippe Padié was born and raised in Burgundy, but always dreamed of returning to his grandparent's home in South-west of France. In 2001, after his wine studies, he moved to the famous village of Calce to make natural wine alongside the Domaine's of Gauby, Matassa, Horizon, and Pithon. He works with no additives or sulphites. His wines are distinctly crafted, with a lifted quality rare in the Roussillon region.

Jean-Philippe works with organic and biodynamic practices to enhance the limestone and schist dominated Mosaic of the Calce terroir. Assisted by the east-west orientations of the many valleys through this rugged land and the strong maritime breezes off the Mediterranean the indigenous grapes such as Carignan, Grenache Noir, Syrah, Grenache Blanc, Grenache Gris and Macabeau thrive to capture the complexity, power, elegance and freshness of the land and climate.

In the winery, all handling is by hand, respecting what nature has delivered. Maceration occurs in concrete vats and aging along with some use of old 600 litre barrels delivering wines of the exceptional balance and identity.

Pierrick Harang comes from humble hard-working roots founded deep in the wine making industry of France. He did not inherit lands or vines from his grandfathers but instead a profound love and knowledge for making great wines, one that goes back five generations of wine merchants and oenologists. His father spent many years working as head winemaker of the famous champagne house GH Munn and Pierrick himself is not only just a winemaker, but also a consultant for many wineries in his region and throughout France.

His cellar is in Perpignan, Southern France in the warm, sun-drenched region of Languedoc-Roussillon. The Le Petit Balthazar wines he produces are uncharacteristically low alcohol for their region, making them approachable and enjoyable to drink.



In the vineyard Pierrick deals with fruit that is certified organic as he champions sustainable viticulture practices that ultimately help produce healthy vigorous vines that eventually produce fresh, vibrant wines of excellent quality.

This estate winery has deep country roots. It's founders were originally share-croppers, then landowners and finally winemakers. Led by Stefano, helped by his wife Giuseppina and his two sons, Tiziano and Daniele they are now making exceptional Valpolicella wines.

The new millennium was very significant for the Stefano Accordini winery. It was decided to move the wine production to their highest vineyard in the Valpolicella Classico area, a move which has allowed the production of wine of excellent quality. The project began with the purchase of 10 hectares in Cavolo, situated in Fumane at 550 metres above sea level (now the highest winery in the zone).

The choice to produce wines in the hills proved to be a winner. The wines are unique both in elegance, taste and bouquet. They are now regarded as one of the finest Valpolicella producers..

Alessandro di Camporeale

Sicily | ITALY

The Alessandro family's roots are very old, steeped in history. With three brothers' Rosolino, Antonino and Natale supported by their children Anna, Benedetto and Benedetto their winery practices are organic and of high quality. They are a fourth-generation family-owned and operated winery located in the small farming town of Camporeale, close to Palermo. The estate is at the foot of a hill overlooking the Mandranova plain where their 35 hectares of vineyards lie at about 400m. The climate is mild and the fertile clay and

limestone-based soil which is ideal for producing a wide variety of grapes. The vineyard follows the overall values of tradition, experience and knowledge of the land, and all vine related activities are carried out by hand, following organic farming principles such as biodiversity and using green manure to promote soil fertility. Today the fourth generation of Anna (law degree) who manages the administration of the business, Benedetto the Oenologist and Benedetto an Agronomist with a degree in wine economics are at the forefront of further developing this outstanding Sicilian winery.

Bellosguardo

Tuscany | ITALY

The Bellosguardo winery was started in the 1970's by Oliviero Viviani.

The winery is situated in Lastra a Signa, a very small village located a few kilometres from Florence and very famous for its historical and pre-historical context.

Oliviero started his career with the family Strozzi in the 50's and then was in charge of the Tenuta Bellosguardo under the De Micheli's family before becoming the owner.

In 1989 Oliviero's sons Cesare and Gabriele came into the new venture to help their father with the activity, so the company took the name of Cantine Bellosguardo and sons.

The two sons gave a new impetus to the company, creating synergies with other farmers and small producers from the area, taking up new technology in order to improve the quality of the vineyards and winemaking.

Campo al Noce sits next to the iconic Sassicaia/San Guido Estate in Bolgheri, as their land was blessed to be a part of the original estate until the early 1960's when sharecropping in Italy was ceased and the sharecroppers had the opportunity to purchase some of the land they worked. It is now owned and family-run by Pierluigi Sgariglia, whose father and grandfather worked for San Guido where they learnt their trade. It is located between Bolgheri and Castagneto Carducci, just 4 km from the sea and so experiences wonderful Mediterranean breezes for those hot Super Tuscan summers.

The winery has recently built a new cellar due to the success of its great quality/price wines.

The Sgariglia family are behind all the production of the wines. They have 6 hectares of vineyards with east-west exposure and are harvested by hand. The grapes are processed in a traditional way, with modern techniques of vinification and bottling to ensure organic certification.

The Canoso family has been the owner of the winery located on the hills of Monteforte d'Alpone since 1876, located very close to Verona.

Canoso works 12 hectares in the hills (between 90m and 290m) in different plots, mostly exposed to the south-east. The vineyards range from between 20 and 45 years of age, with a guyot system which has gradually replaced the traditional Veronese Pergola, reducing production quantity hence improving quality. The harvest, and most other operations carried out in the vineyards, are done completely by hand.

In 2016 the Canoso family with the help of Giovanni and Francesco have relaunched the brand and established themselves as high quality wines producers proud of the volcanic territory of Soave.

Cantalici

Tuscany | ITALY

Cantalici today is owned by the brothers Daniele and Carlo. They inherited the winery from their father Loris, who originally bought it in 1972 as it was an ancient kiln (Antica Fornace di Ridolfi).

Located in the famous Gaiole in Chianti in the Classico area, Cantalici is a family run winery, which respects the tradition and history.

The brothers chose to start producing wine organically after years spent working in tight connection with Chianti Classico vineyards.

Their Chianti Classico is the expression of the terroir and the Cantalici's produce an exceptional Chianti in one of best areas to produce Chianti Classico.

In 1956, 11 Trentino farmers combined forces to create the Cantina Sociale in their city thus forming a wine cooperative with the sole purpose of defending and promoting the area and its products thanks to the union of those who live and work in the area every day.

They wanted the winery where grapes are transformed into wine to be a place of respect for nature. This guided in the choice of local materials, but above all in choosing cutting edge technology solutions compatible with the environment and aimed at continuous quality improvement.

The production of "Trentino DOC" wines has led to the development a "Nativi" range, characterised by a profound bond with the Trentino "DOC" territory. This bond is reflected in the wines' labels, which feature "native" animals from Trentino's extraordinary fauna. All the wines reveal a strong personality, drawn from the purity of the mountainous territory from whence they derive.

Cantina Orsogna, created in 1964, is a Co-Operative company. Set in the scenic Majella hills of Abruzzo, just 15 kilometres from the Adriatic, its vineyard's benefit from the significant day-night temperature swings and ventilation in the vineyards thanks to the fresh breezes which result from both its altitude and its maritime location.

The Estate was named 'Italian Winery of the Year' at Vinitaly in 2012. It is the largest producer of Organic and Biodynamic wines in the south-centre of Italy. It has more than 1,100 hectares of vines, 80% are certified organic, and 30% are certified biodynamic by Demeter. Cantina Orsogna has been Certified Biodynamic since 2005 and has been Organic producers for more than 30 years. The winemaking team is headed by the super-talented Camillo Zulli. The Lunaria wines are certified Biodynamic by Demeter.

Caruso & Minini

Sicily | ITALY

Caruso & Minini, is the story of two families that intertwine and merge when wine makers Stefano, Francesco and Roberto Caruso, meet Mario and Francesco Minini, owners of a marketing company in Northern Italy. Together they build the foundations of Caruso & Minini Estate of the art winery in Marsala in Western Sicily.

A new joint venture characterised by tradition and competence, with a look into the future. In fact, today Stefano is flanked by his two daughters Giovanna and Rosanna who are actively taking part in the daily work at the winery. Management in pink that has brought a breath of freshness among the barrels.

Giumarella and Cutaja are the names of the family vineyards from where the wines come from. This land hosts local grapes such as Grillo, Catarratto, Grecanico, Inzolia, Zibibbo, Nero d'Avola, Frappato and Perricone, along with some international varieties. Every single grapevine was planted following the best combination of exposure, soil and climate.

A perfect combination of mild microclimate and very ancient soils that give Prosecco unique aromatic and sensory notes.

Castello di Corbara

Umbria | ITALY

For almost forty years the estate has been the proud owner of an extremely valuable viticultural patrimony, with about 100 hectares of vineyards located at altitudes ranging from 100 to 350 meters above sea level, enjoying an excellent exposure and interesting vegetative materials.

One of the principal objectives the estate is aiming at is that of revaluating the autochthonous species of grapes that have been growing here for over a century, so as to put on the market wines intimately connected with the territory of origin.

Castello di Corbara has always operated in respect for the environment guaranteeing the production of authentic wines and with the need to salvage values such as the respect of the territory, whose authenticity is always reflected by every single wine produced.

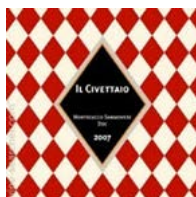
IL Civettaio produces award winning organic and biodynamic red wines, typical of the Maremma . The cultivation is strictly organic and biodynamic and all the Civettaio wines are certified organic.

As an organic winemaker Gregorio relies on nature to do most of the work. He is fortunate to have a great region to grow his grapes at the foothills of Montalcino. Piero Antinori believes the Montecucco area is most conducive to the quality growth of Sangiovese in Italy. As a result, Gregorio's wines age beautifully with elegance and balance. The vineyards cover 8 hectares.

The work of the soil, pruning and weed control are strictly organic. Grapes are harvested manually and immediately brought to the cellar. Fermentation takes place in 4 and 5 hectolitre oak barrels and part in stainless steel with natural methods such as the use of indigenous yeasts, and natural malolactic fermentation.

Eno-Trio

Enò-Trio, originates from the history of a family very closely connected to the territory. Nunzio Puglisi and his two daughters, Stefany and Désirée constitute the trio of Enò-Trio.

The lands are located in four districts and in turn in three different municipalities all falling on the slopes of Etna North and North-West at altitudes ranging from 650 meters to 1100 meters above sea level where the three varieties of grapes are grown.

The philosophy of Eno-Trio is "Wine is produced in the vineyards not in the cellar". This is what makes their wines so unique.

Enrico Rivetto

Piedmont | ITALY

Enrico Rivetto was the first estate in the Barolo and Barbaresco regions of Piedmont to achieve biodynamic status at Demeter, one of the largest certification bodies.

Rivetto's entire, 100,000 bottle annual production is certified biodynamic, starting with its 2019 vintage wines.

Originally founded in 1902, Rivetto was established in its current location in the Barolo commune of Serralunga d'Alba in 1938.

Enrico Rivetto, the fourth generation of the family, joined the property full-time in 1999 and started converting to organic viticulture in 2009. He received certification in 2016.

'Organic isn't complete as it only governs the things you aren't allowed to use,' Rivetto said, referring to the proscription of synthetic fertilisers, fungicides, herbicides and pesticides. Little by little, he added elements of biodynamic practices. He planted ancient strains of corn and wheat, aromatic herbs and perennial flowers along with 550 trees to create a biodiverse environment.

In total, Rivetto sacrificed 1.2ha of vines leaving 15ha in production. Most of the 35ha property is enclosed by forest, providing a natural border with neighbouring vineyards.

The Azienda Agricola Fabiana is owned and managed by mother and daughter, Anna and Fabiana Barulli.

They operate the winery utilizing only sustainable practices with no chemical herbicides.

The 30 hectares of the Fabiana farm are on a calcareous clay soil which allows it to produce wines of great personality and intensity, influenced by the proximity of the sea and the warm temperatures.

The vines have an age ranging from 5 to 50 years, the processes are carried out with the utmost respect for nature using organic products.

The harvest is carried out at night for the white wines and scrupulously by hand for the red wines to ensure that the bunches remain intact in their aromas.

The winery is located on the Ionian coast in the province of Taranto, the most notable area for Primitivo di Manduria.

The winery is located in Rovereto di Gavi, in the heart of the historic area of Gavi D.O.C.G. of the Municipality of Gavi.

The first bottles were produced in 1988 with the arrival of Marco and Roberto Gemme in the winery and in cooperation with the oenologist Gaspare Buscemi.

Fontanassa is an old fortified farmhouse from 16th century. Already in a sharecropping contract dated December 27, 1634 with the cultivation of white and red grapes.

Over the centuries it was owned by important Genoese families until 31 December 1921 when it was bought by Marco and Roberto's great-grandfather Citù.

The vineyards are located on a clay soil with stones and iron sands with a south and south- west exposure at a height of 290-330 m.

The winery has an area of 77 hectares of which 35 are currently planted with vineyards, guyot trained.

The harvest of the grapes is carried out by hand and farming is organic and sustainable.

The winery, directly set in the landscape framework of Borgo di Fugnano, over time, has undergone continuous modernization, allowing it to achieve the high standards that it has today.

Generazione Alessandro is the new winery started 5 years ago by the 3 cousins who are the 4th Generation of Alessandro di Camporeale.

Strengthened by years of honing a wide range of skills – Benedetto in Oenology, Anna in Law, and Benedetto in Agronomics and Economics – and working at their family's winery, Alessandro di Camporeale, they have started this new venture together on Mt Etna.

The wines are fantastic and speak volumes to the identity of their experience and the terroir of Mt Etna.

The cousins farm about 10 hectares on the North-east side of the volcano, in 2 adjacent communes, Castiglione di Sicilia and Linguaglossa. Even though all the vineyards are located on plots of land quite close in proximity to each other, all have differing geomorphological and microclimate characteristics, which influence the yield of the grapes. Among new plantings are quite a few high-density plots of old vines, trained in the Alberello system, all farmed sustainably.

The Giannetti's in Montalcino are a wonderful winemaking family, who are compassionate, passionate and just simpatici about winemaking. From peasant roots ("Mezzadri" in Italian meaning share-croppers) the family has been on the land in Montalcino for many generations. It was only in 1964, when the Government stopped share-cropping, they were able to purchase the land and realise their dream of creating fine wine under their own label of La Fornace. The wines from La Fornace are starting to make a great impression on the world stage and are regularly rated in the 90+ points range.

Fabio Giannetti is now the owner and winemaker of La Fornace, working closely with his father Franco who works with the vines to ensure they are in optimal condition prior to harvest. They work with the Biodynamic philosophy and following the moon and sun to determine pruning and harvesting etc.

Today La Fornace produces Brunello di Montalcino, Rosso di Montalcino DOC and, in the best vintages of Brunello Riserva DOCG.

Le Chiuse has very famous pedigree as they are a part of the original Biondi Santi family and part of their vineyards are where Franco produced his award winning Riserva Brunellos. The Estate came into the possession of the Biondi Santi family at the end of the 18th century. Ferruccio Biondi Santi continued the work of his grandfather Clemente by selecting and enhancing vines until he obtained a particular clone of Sangiovese Grosso which became the source of the original Brunello di Montalcino.

Ferruccio's son Tancredi bequeathed Le Chiuse to his daughter Fiorella, urging her never to sell the estate. From then on Fiorella leased the farms to her brother Franco, owner of the renowned Il Greppo estate, who cultivated the vineyards and vinified the grapes until 1990. When Fiorella died in 1986, her daughter Simonetta Valiani, began to produce her own Brunello from Le Chiuse. With great dedication, she worked with her husband Nicolò Magnelli and son Lorenzo in restoring the estate buildings and chapel, constructing an underground cellar and planting new vineyards.

The estate comprises 18 hectares of woods, vineyards and olive groves. Brunello vineyards lie on the north, north-eastern slopes of the Montalcino hill at about 330 meters above sea level. There are five vineyards, all planted in Sangiovese Grosso with an average age of 15 years or over. The soil is of oceanic origin, so rich in marine fossils with streaks of clay and a notable presence of marl and tufa. These conditions favour wines which exalt aromas and flavours, with ample body and fluent equilibrium of alcohol content.

The pre-eminence of Le Chiuse is evidenced by its international ratings. Over the past four years Le Chiuse Brunello has achieved two perfect scores of 100 points from Wine Enthusiast and exceptionally high rankings in other publications eg Vinous Media, Decanter & Jancis Robinson.

Giovanni Manzone

Piedmont | ITALY

In 1925 Giovanni Manzone purchased "Ciabot del Preve" (the Parish Priest house) and he started the winemaking in Monforte d'Alba. Manzone's high-elevation vineyards and their extreme steepness foster naturally low-yielding vines which produce wines that are approachable while young, yet remain amongst the most concentrated and longest-lived of all Barolos. During the years the Manzone family purchased important vineyards on the historic hill of "CASTELLETTO" and "GRAMOLERE", two of the best Crus in Monforte d'Alba.

The Manzone family expresses the essence of Langhe, humble origins that have made wines great, because they were born out of an authentic passion.

A strip of land that rises on the ridge of Perno, at around 450 meters, atop which rises the Manzone winery. Manzone is in a magnificent crossroads: Castiglione Falletto to the north, Monforte d'Alba to the south, Barolo to the west, Serralunga d'Alba to the east, in a valley of steep slopes, surrounded by ancient woods and held by the majestic Alpine arc on the horizon.

No clarification, no filtration and minimum use of sulphur during bottling. Spontaneous fermentation, delicate and slow maceration on the skins and pips, delivers exceptional Barolo's and Lange Nebbiolo.

The Manzone Barolos always receive high recognition and ratings by the international press.

Manuel's a young wine producer, who graduated from Alba's viticultural school Umberto I, which he graduated from in the mid 1990s. After graduation, Manuel worked abroad & locally for both large and small cantine/wineries before purchasing the San Rocco Seno d'Elvio vineyard in 2002. Vintage 2004 was his first release. Manuel specialises in Barbaresco and Langhe Rosso which uses an indigenous grape of Freisa.

Refreshingly Manuel immediately adopted the traditional approach to winemaking. His Nebbiolo for Barbaresco is vinified in cement without temperature control using selected yeast.

An outstanding Barbaresco Producer. A five-generation family winery, Massimo Rivetti has 25 hectares cultivated under organic certification with indigenous yeast and no pesticides or chemicals used. Annual production is around 100,000 bottles, mainly divided between Barbaresco and Barbera d'Alba. All the fields are grouped around Froi, Garassino and Palazzina. The Winery is located in Froi where it is built on Serraboella hill, one of the most important for the production of Barbaresco. The vineyards are favourably exposed to South, South-West.

The winery has vineyards from 35 to 75 years old with limited yield per hectare to maximize the grape quality, the terroir and production area. All weeding and vine management work is done by hand to avoid any herbicide, including the use of 20+ different variety of herbs which help plants to avoid stress and act as a natural fertilizer. Only yeasts that are naturally present on the skins of the berries are used, in order to obtain wines which reflect the territory and production area.

The winery has remained in the Medici family for generations with a strong commitment to maintaining traditional winemaking practices while also embracing modern production techniques.

Medici Ermete specializes in the production of Lambrusco, a wine that became particularly important in the 1970s as it was amongst the first Italian wines to be exported.

The key to their success was forging a strong connection between the territory and the wines produced, coupled with a rigorous grape selection process which ensured an unprecedented level of quality.

Tuscany | ITALY

The story of the estate began in 1983 with Michele, of Sardinian origins, and it was on that island that, while still a boy, his real passion for the land initiated. He rediscovered the same intense excitement when he transferred to Tuscany. While working as a labourer Castagneto Carducci in the heart of the Bolgheri DOC, he learned that the farming tradition is an incredibly important heritage that has to be preserved, with patience and respect.

The peculiarity of the DOC Bolgheri is in the presence of the sea for three main reasons: the first is that it reflects sunlight thus bringing the grape to very complex phenolic ripening. The second aspect is that the sea provides thermal balance and finally, there are winds blowing toward the coast making the air less saturated with water.

Mirabella produces outstanding Franciacorta, made with organic grapes and true respect for the land.

Born in Pavia in 1949, winemaker Teresio Schiavi moved to Franciacorta in 1978. He started Mirabella in the heart of Franciacorta a year later with his partner Giacomo Cavalli, and the two of them produced the first 3,200 bottles in 1980. Mirabella began production with about 11 hectares but rapidly grew to 16 hectares with additional plantings of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Blanc.

Between 1980 and 1984, Mirabella continued to expand by transforming from a Cooperative into an Agricultural Society. In 1985, the company headquarters moved from Paderno Franciacorta to its current location in Rodengo Saiano, and the larger facilities and underground cellars provided them with more space to efficiently process grapes. Additionally, the humidity and temperature were optimal for aging on the lees and in bottle. The overall production area grew to 40 hectares, which allowed Mirabella to produce 450,000 bottles per year of Franciacorta DOCG, Brut, Rose, Satèn, Vintage and Reserves.

Mirabella is careful not to neglect the eco-compatibility in both the vineyard — where production is certified with low environmental impact — and in the cellar — where they source 100% of energy from renewable sources.

Today Teresio's two sons Alessandro and Alberto, respectively are in the business as Cellar Master and Marketing and Commercial Director.

At the foot of the 'Muntagna' the name fondly used to refer to the Etna in 2010 the Costanzo family acquired and restored the Palmento – a place traditional reserved for the pressing of grapes, on a scale never seen before in Sicily. Along with the purchase of a handful of hectares, including a centuries old, ungrafted vineyard, one of the few that survived the phylloxera epidemic a dream was born.

The vineyards of Palmento Costanzo are in the Contrada Santo Spirito, in Passopisciaro. The family cultivates 18 hectares today between Passopisciaro and Santa Maria di Licodia in the heart of the Parco Naturale dell'Etna, a UNESCO world heritage site.

The winery is led by Valeria Agosta and her daughter Serena who both share a bond with the land that turns into a desire to cultivate vineyards, understand the terroir of the Etna and its infinite nuances, to make wine of excellence.

In Contrada Santo Spirito, volcanic rocks emerge on the surface called sciare. These are the remains of the lava flow that in 1879 created the unique soils rich in minerals and shaped the landscape to garner all the benefits of the climate of the Etna that now Palmento Costanzo lovingly cultivate. The vines on these lands are more than a hundred years old and are trained using the albarello technique.

This is heroic viticulture, exclusively carried out by hand and under organic management. The vines climb up the slopes of the Etna along dry-stone terraces. Blessed with an excellent diurnal temperature variation and other climatic conditions the vines using their deep roots can endure the heat and drought of the summer and develop grapes of an exceptional aromatic profile.

It is the geological abundance of the Etna combined with the prosperous climate and the touch of the team at Palmento Costanzo that leads to excellent viticulture and wines of remarkable quality.

Pietroso

The Pignattai family have roots to this estate and land dating back to the 1970s but the history of this land as a place of high-quality viticulture known as the 'El Petroso Contrada' goes back much further, as far back as the thirteenth & fourteenth century.

The vineyards now are planted exclusively with Sangiovese and are situated in three distinctive areas within the boundaries of Montalcino which allows for balanced production even in difficult years. With an ideal microclimate at an altitude of between 350 to 450 meters, along with rich soils and the attentive manual work carried out by the family and team the vines are capable of producing bunches of the highest quality.

The procedures in the winery are kept to a minimum where long fermentation periods and the patient use of 30hl oak barrels, over 3 years for their Brunello and 12 months for their Rosso and further investments in time in bottle allows the wine to reach an optimum level upon release as well as the potential for years of aging.

Their aim from the start was to create two exceptional wines: Rosso di Montalcino DOC and Brunello di Montalcino DOCG, and this was realised in 2009 when the Querce Bettina wines were first released.

The Querce Bettina wines are hand-made on the estate by Roberto and Sandra with the help of a small, expert team and take advantage of the perfect setting for optimal production. Located at an average of 440m above sea level on the south-west slopes of Montalcino the property benefits from breathless views towards Mount Amiata and down towards the Maremma coast.

Marco Speri is part of the fifth generation of wine producers of Valpolicella. From knowledge gained through his father, he created his new company 'SECONDO MARCO' in Fumane in the heart of the Valpolicella Classica region, where there are all the elements in order to produce special wines, from the land to the climate. Between Verona and Lake Garda, at the foot of the Lessini Mountains, where an intersection of winds, cold from the mountains and mild from the lake, are particularly favourable for the vine.

His desire to blend tradition and innovation results in the choice to implement a Y shape system for the vineyard that does not require invasive maintenance. Grapes are handpicked and harvested in an easier way and without running the risk of being damaged, preserving the character of the grapes of this region and directing these changes in his own way.

Tradition helps, as does technological innovation, but the most important thing is intuition and the ability to transform the passing of time into an original flavour that is different every year.

Tenuta di Tavignano was founded by Stefano Aymerich di Laconi and Beatrice Lucanegli where until the 1990s the estate's activities were based on the cultivation of cereals, vegetables and fodder crops. Then the decision was taken to plant and cultivate indigenous wine varieties of the territory.

In 2014, Odine de la Feld Aymerich, an arch-designer with a past in fashion but a strong tradition in agricultural entrepreneurship, joined Tenuta di Tavignano along with the granddaughter of Stefano and Beatrice and marked the green turn of the entire production with their modern, dynamic and entrepreneurial style.

The estate is now certified organic and the approach by the family is completely and proudly sustainable. Their profound knowledge of the land and its history along with the exceptional characteristics of the DOC Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi is their secret.

Today the entire estate stretches over 230 hectares of land with 30 dedicated to vines. The vineyards are managed meticulously, hand-picked, respecting the plant's life cycle, promoting biodiversity and healthy self-sufficient vines.

Cristina Scarpellini, wine producer in Valtellina since 2008, is the soul of Tenuta Scerscè. She and her team are strongly motivated to create wines that are a direct expression of their territory and that can convey their mindset and personality along with a tenacious search for quality.

Tenuta Scerscè today extends over seven hectares at an altitude between 400 and 720 metres above sea level with an excellent exposure to the South – Southeast. The winery's development has been gradual and determined by a thorough search for the right plots of land in the most wine-specialised area where the Nebbiolo grape, here called Chiavennasca, can flourish.

The perfect microclimate enhanced by the protection given from the Alps and the breeze known as the 'Breva del Lago di Como' that flows through the valley drying the leaves of the vines protecting them from disease along with the up to 1,500 hours of manual work per hectare contributes to preserving the biodiversity and an advantage for great continuous conditions for excellent development of grape bunches and grape ripening.

Valtellina, a gem in the world of wine is one of the few longitudinal alpine valleys and the largest terraced vineyard area in Italy. The outstanding architecture of the 2,500km of stoned walls and terraced vineyards, which are now a UNESCO Intangible Heritage site show the beauty and care of the manual labour of humankind and a commitment to excellence in wine.

It wasn't until 1986 when Vincenzo took over from his father, that the vineyard was expanded and from there the first wines with great personality including "Il Bell'Antonio Chianti DOCG were born.

Terre di San Gorgone is one of the members of the winemakers associations Consorzio del Vino Chianti, established in 1927 with the mission to protect and promote Chianti D.O.C.G. wine.

Founded in the 1960s in the heart of the Vino Nobile di Montepulciano region in south-eastern Tuscany the Valdipiatta estate owned by the Caporali family and now run by Miriam is one of the true custodians of this historic wine growing region and appellation.

An oasis of biodiversity which has taken years of commitment, the Valdipiatta vineyards coexist with plants Miriam sows each autumn between the vine rows. The so-called cover crops keep the soil and its all-important organisms well fed attracting beneficial insects creating a natural balance against predatory insects helping protect the Montepulciano terroir and preserve the true expression of Vino Nobile.

The nurturing that occurs in the vineyard and the minimal, patient and concerted approach in the winery through the use of exceptional oak and other means produces wines, highlighted by the Vino Nobile which respect tradition while understanding the palates of today's wine lovers. The project Nepeta was born in Syracuse in 2017 from the will of Federico and Andrea. The two cousins decided to engage in the recovery of a Sicilian herb unknown to most through the production of an Amaro first and then of chocolate: the Nepitella.

The Catmint (Calamintha Nepèta) is a perennial aromatic plant, similar to mint in the aroma, which grows above five hundred meters of altitude on the rocky plateaus of the Iblei Mountains between Palazzolo Acreide and the Val di Noto.

The bottles, of French manufacture, recall the ancient cruets of apothecaries, the contrasting label has a minimal and fresh graphic that refers to the clean taste of Bitter Nepeta.

This unique Sicilian Bitter it boasts very pleasant notes of wild mint at the first sip which then transform into a slightly bitter persistence given by the peel of the Syracuse lemon PGI and has a herbaceous aftertaste thanks to the Sicilian wild herbs.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Under the Liquor Act 2007 it is against the law to sell or supply alcohol to, or to obtain alcohol on behalf of, a person under the age of 18 years. Any person buying wine who is under 18 years or is buying wine for anyone under 18 years is in breach of the Liquor Act 2007 and will be subject to prosecution. Trading entities such as restaurants and bottle shops will be required to quote their liquor licence number on or before ordering.
- Minimum order is 12 bottles and \$300 unless otherwise agreed. Orders below 12 bottles may attract an additional charge for picking cost and delivery.
- New customers will be required to complete a credit application before the first order is processed. The customer agrees to the terms and conditions outlined here and on the credit application.
- Payment terms are in full by the 30th of the month following the month of purchase. Failure to meet these terms will result in future orders being denied and may lead to recovery action being taken by Italian wine importers. Payments should be made to Italian Wine Importers, CBA, BSB 062-692, Account 32504090.
- All goods will be at customers risk upon delivery. No credits will be available for wine held over 90 days. Upon delivery the wine will still be legally owned by Italian Wine Importers until payment in full for that delivery is made.
- The customer must notify Italian wine importers in writing of any full or partial change of ownership within 48 hours of such change.
- Prices are subject to change without notice and whilst Italian wine importers will undertake to keep its portfolio up to date there may be occasions where pricing is different. The customer will be liable to pay the Wine Equalization Tax on the goods unless, at the time goods are ordered, the customer validly requests exemption and provides their ABN and exemption proof. In addition GST will be payable at 10% on the invoice price.
- Credit Cards. We accept credit cards. Visa and Mastercard will attract a 1.5% surcharge and American Express a 1.75% surcharge.
- Orders should be with Italian Wine Importers before 1pm on a business day.
